### Terms & Conditions

*Please read the terms and conditions below before completing the booking form.  
These conditions should be retained for your reference; failure to adhere to these conditions may result in you being asked to vacate the site.*

- a) Please return all completed booking forms with correct payment (if applicable) as soon as possible to guarantee your booking but no later than Monday 31<sup>st</sup> August 2009.
- b) The site will be open from 10am on Friday 25<sup>th</sup> September 2009. Please vacate the site by 12pm on Monday 28<sup>th</sup> September 2009. Please contact the organiser if you wish to arrive earlier.
- c) Report to the event office on arrival to book in and collect your weekend passes. Please keep vehicle and personal passes on show at all times.
- d) No SS groups or displays are permitted on site.
- e) All weapons must comply with H.M. Government Legislation. Deactivation certificates must be carried at all times. The use of blank firers is restricted to the battle scenarios only.
- f) If you require camping over the weekend please complete the relevant section on the Booking Form. Camping for re-enactors and exhibitors is free of charge. No modern tents, vehicles or caravans etc. are permitted within the display area.
- g) There will be a strict 5mph speed limit on site, please adhere to this at all times and follow the instructions of the marshals. Entry and exit will be via a one way system. Please be aware of pedestrians whilst moving around the site.
- h) All vehicles and exhibits should be in position by 10am and should remain on display until 5pm on both days. Any movement of display vehicles during these times is strictly prohibited due to the safety of the general public. Contact an event official in the site office if you must move during these times.
- i) Children are to be supervised at all times.
- j) Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times. Please clean up after them and place all waste in the bins provided.
- k) No open fires or disposable BBQ's are permitted on site.
- l) Please place any litter in the bins provided. Glass should be separated for recycling.
- m) Toilets are located on the station platform and within the main site and camping area. Chemical toilet waste should be disposed of in the elsan waste disposal point.
- n) Water is available on site.
- o) Please be considerate to other road users and local villagers when entering/leaving the site.
- p) Should you experience any problems during the weekend, please report to the Site Office. Opening times are 9am to 6pm.
